SAFE TRANSPORT POLICY

The Policy

The Wyndhamvale Football Club recognises that alcohol is served at our club and that as a club we are responsible for the safety of our members. In doing so the club shall ensure our members are aware of this policy and are encouraged to make alternative transport arrangements when consuming alcohol at such functions.

- Bar staff shall encourage members and visitors to make alternate safe transport arrangements if they are considered to exceed .05 blood alcohol concentration.
- Telephone calls will be made free of charge to arrange a taxi or other transport.
- In specific cases, where a designated driver who has been nominated by the club and that person has accepted the responsibility to drive others home safely, will be provided non alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club.
- In specific cases, bar servers will be provided non-alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club.
- In specific cases and where available club transport will be provided to/from events.
- Committee will pre-order taxis to arrive at the venue at the conclusion of the function.

Who Is Affected By This Policy

This policy applies to all members, administrators, officials, coaches, players and visitors of the Wyndhamvale Football Club.

Timing

This policy is effective from 01 March 2016.

Policy Review

The policy will be reviewed three months after its introduction and then on an annual basis thereafter. This will ensure that the policy remains current and practical.

Policy Commencemet

This Policy was passed by the Club's Football Committee and will take effect from 01 March 2013.
